The regular meeting of the Board will start at 7:15 p.m. The Board will also hold its organizational meeting to elect a chairman and vice chairman and set meeting dates for 2009.

Citizens interested in commenting on the budget may speak during the public hearing. The meeting will be held at the Government Center, 755 Roanoke St., Christiansburg, on the second floor. Other important dates during the County's budget process include:

- March 9, FY10 budget proposal presented at Board of Supervisors regular meeting
- March 26, public hearing on advertised tax rate and budget, Board of Supervisors special meeting
- April 13, establish tax rate and adopt budget, Board of Supervisors regular meeting
- July 1, new fiscal year begins
